

2005 AIA Award Winner

We are pleased to announce that the American Institute of Architects Houston Design Awards has honored Bailey Architects with a prestigious 2005 Merit Award for The Awty International Lower School.

The facility consists of six classrooms per grade level clustered into “small villages” around a commons, a library, and a multi-purpose room. The exterior of the building was restored to reflect materials used throughout the entire campus, while the interior was designed to retain the campus character of industrial architecture mixed with over-scaled elements, bright colors and energetic shapes.

Founded in 1956, The Awty International School is the second largest international school in the United States. The school offers qualified students (PK-12) a challenging education and sound preparation for higher education. The school expects students to acquire fluency in at least two languages, an understanding of community and world affairs, and an appreciation of different cultures through both academic and extra-curricular activities.

Bailey Architects' award-winning design for the school captures the international spirit of this unique educational facility.
