Issue of results to universities and colleges

A university (or college) may require evidence of a candidate's results directly from the IBO. On request, the results for a candidate will be sent directly to the university, or university admissions center, in electronic format. Alternatively, if the results cannot be sent electronically, a transcript of the results will be sent.

The IB Coordinator will make the request to IBO on behalf of a student. Requests for this service should be submitted to the IB Coordinator prior to the deadlines given below.

When completing a request for the UK Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS), a candidate's nine digit UCAS application number must be included.
